Board of Directors Update By Carol Hassemer

Opening day was Saturday, May 25th! The Swiss Historical Village will be open through Harvest Fest on Sunday, October 13th. A small number of groups, including school tours, have been set up. We hope to see you at the museum this year!

The Board of Directors met on Wednesday, May 7th. Treasurer Freitag reported that the balance sheet through March showed a 0.5% increase, mainly due to interest accrued on CDs. Net income through March was down \$17,662 with income higher than 2023, but Gift Shop purchases for the season, Facilities & Equipment, Building & Grounds, and Advertising expenses higher, mainly related to opening for the season. The expense for the PastPerfect archival software purchase is included but will be offset once the grant check is received from the Community Foundation of Southern Wisconsin.

The murals for the Hall of History, highlighting Canton Glarus, are completed, and were installed before May's Opening Day. These murals were generously funded by the people of Switzerland. Watch for more details. Kudos to Jackie Judd-Scheurer for shepherding this project, which included working across the ocean with Jarryd who was the designer in Switzerland, and Vital Signs of Verona!

Culver's of New Glarus supported the Historical Society by donating a portion of sales on Thursday, May 9th, from 4:00 – 7:00 pm, with Society members delivering food to guests. The Society greatly appreciates the support offered by Culver's. Be sure to thank them next time you dine there!

Due to scheduling and advertising challenges, the new Society event, "Just Cheese It!" scheduled for Saturday, June 15th has been cancelled. Watch for more information on the event in 2025.

The Board approved submitting grant applications to purchase photography equipment for the PastPerfect archiving of collectibles, documents, and photographs, and to cover costs related to replacing badly needed cedar shake shingles on several Historic Village buildings. It will be a few months before we know if the Society is awarded those grants.


