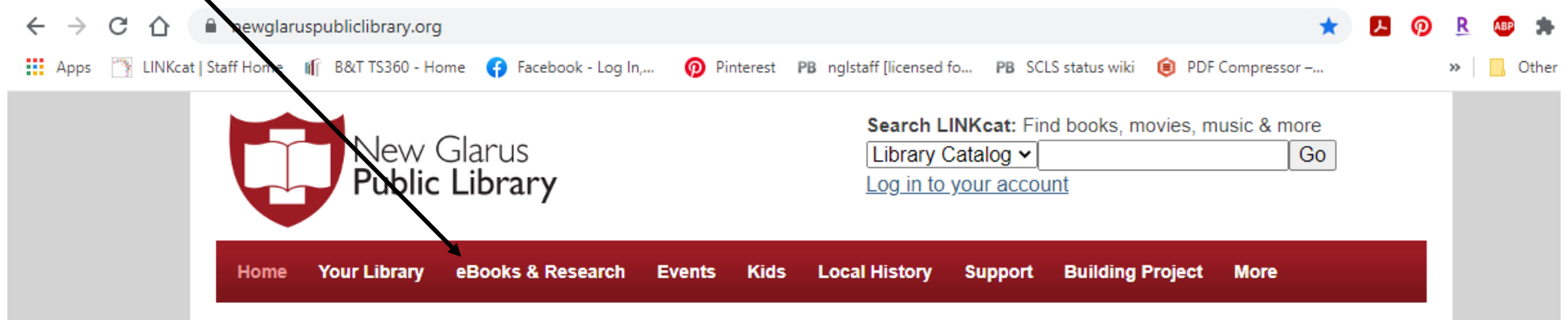


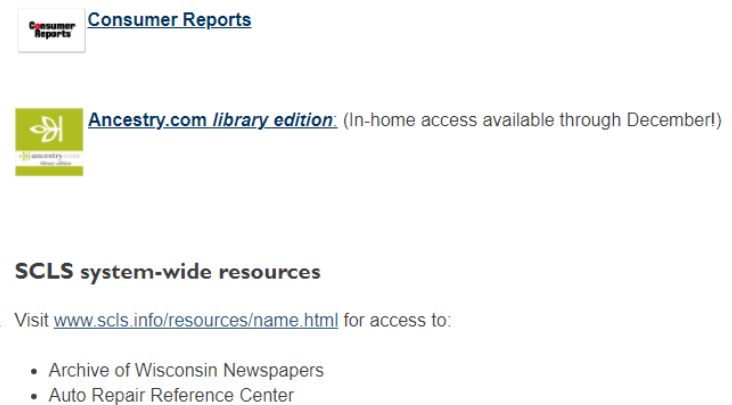
Searching old issues of the New Glarus Post

Issues of the New Glarus Post from 1912-1933 have been digitized and are available through the Archive of Wisconsin Newspapers. Here's how to access those papers.

1. Visit the library's website at www.newglaruspubliclibrary.org. On the red navigation bar near the top of the page, click on "eBooks & Research."



2. On the eBooks & Research page, scroll down until you see the heading for SCLS System-Wide Resources. Click on the link provided.



3. From the SCLS System-Wide Resources page, scroll down until you find the Archive of Wisconsin Newspapers, and click on that link.

Note that at this point you may be prompted to enter your library card number. Enter the whole number without spaces. If you do not have a library card, contact the library at staff@ngpl.org for assistance.

4. When you get to the Wisconsin Newspaper Association site, you want to switch your view to “Search Historical Newspapers” (the pink button on the far right side of the screen).

5. From here you can enter your search terms.

- ♦ All newspapers are selected by default. Just below the list of papers click the “uncheck all” link. Then you will need to scroll down through the list of publications to select “New Glarus Post.”
- ♦ If you are searching for a specific event and you know the approximate date, you may set your own custom date range. When searching for obituaries, it’s best to set the end date to at least one month after the date of death, as notices were sometimes slow to appear.
- ♦ For the widest range of results, keep your search terms simple. With this database, overly specific search terms may actually *exclude* pertinent articles. A search of “Halloween” will yield better results than “School Halloween Costume Party.”
- ♦ When searching for people, keep in mind that women may be referred to by their husband’s name—i.e. Palma Ott may be referenced only as Mrs. Thomas Ott.

6. Scroll down and you will see your results on the right-hand side of the screen. Each result should have a snippet of text with your search words highlighted.

The center column will list the date and page number of the paper. To see the full page, click on the small red Adobe icon next to "download page." This will open a full PDF of the page for you. From there you can zoom in to read each article, save, and print.

7. To start a new search or to refine your results, scroll back up to the top of the page and update your search terms.
