
The population the library serves is defined by an estimate called the service population. The service population is a combination of the Village and Town population, plus a percentage, based on circulation statistics, of surrounding Towns and Counties who are not already served by a library.

Service population is calculated annually, and the chart below from 2001 to 2011 clearly indicates that the service population of the New Glarus Public Library is growing, and the growth is consistent with projections done at the

and the growth is consistent with projections done at the outset of the building process.

Everyone agrees that the current library is too small. What is evident from the chart is that construction of a new building that is undersized from the beginning will only result in additional space problems because of the clear trend toward increasing service population size. Choosing to invest in a library that supports the growing community well into the



future makes New Glarus a more attractive place for families and businesses alike. After all, schools and libraries are the institutions of lifelong learning that offer the greatest hope for improving the lives of residents, both young and old, regardless of income or family background.
